New Central Intake System for hip and knee surgeries:

pilot project in Vitalité Health Network zones 1B and 6

Objective

Improve access to hip and knee replacement surgery by centralizing osteoarthritis referrals.

Why this project?

- Reduction of wait times
 - Thanks to an automated system, patients are referred to the first available orthopedic surgeon according to clinical priority and date of request.
- Fairness and transparency
 - All patients have access to timely assessment, simplified follow-up and improved communication.
- Enhanced preoperative support
 - Integration of collaborative access with physiotherapy, including programs such as GLA:D for improved surgical preparation.

How does it work?

- Referrals sent by fax
 All referrals should be sent to 1-506-317-2452.
- Electronic referrals (website) Coming soon.

The system sorts the referrals, determines their urgency based on a standardized form, and allocates cases to surgeons according to availability.

Key features for improving the experience

- Email and SMS notifications to patients
- Automated appointment tracking
- Equitable workload distribution
- Secure interface with remote access



Next steps

- Pilot project rollout: zones 1B and 6
- Official launch date: June 23, 2025
